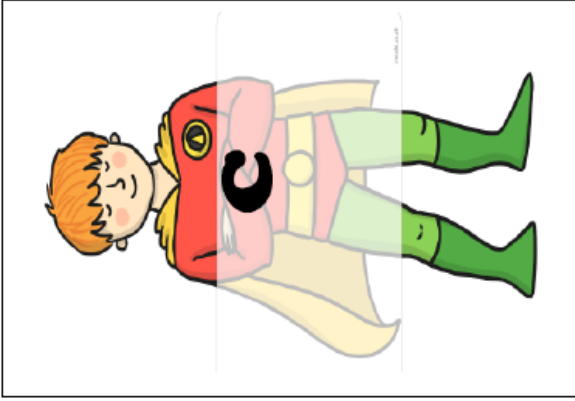

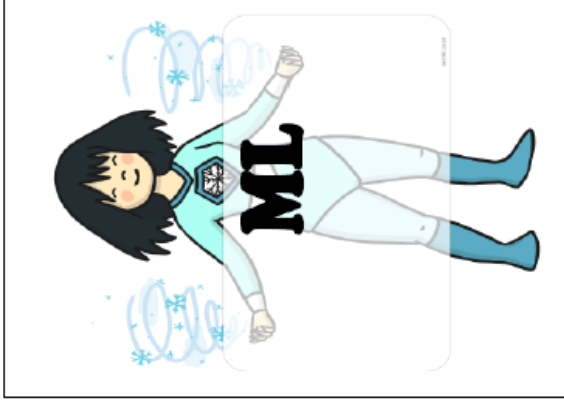
ATTENDANCE— Dutch

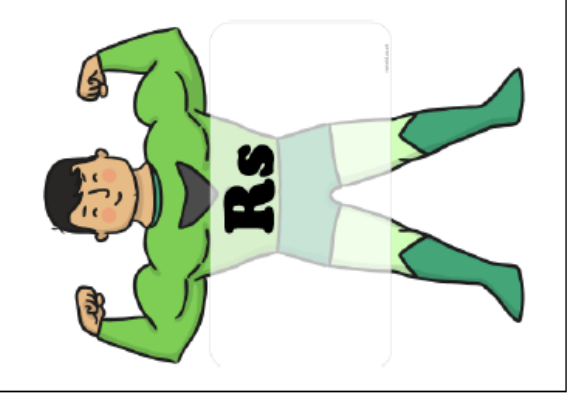
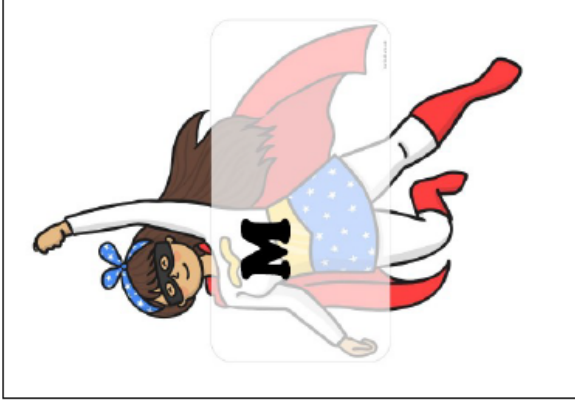
